The **Center for RNA Biology** is soliciting applications for <u>one year</u> of graduate fellowship support. Three fellowships will be available for students in member labs at OSU. Applications are <u>due Wednesday, May 1, 2024</u> and fellowship support will begin Autumn Term 2024. Fellowship support is limited to students who are working in a member lab within the Center for RNA Biology. Projects that involve collaborative interactions between labs of the Center for RNA Biology are strongly encouraged.

Eligible students must: 1) carry out research in the area of RNA biology, and 2) be entering the second, third or fourth year of graduate study in Fall 2024. **Applicants must present a poster at the 2024 Annual RNA Symposium (May 7, 2024).** The evaluation process will be similar to that used for NIH predoctoral grant applications and will include evaluation of the quality of the poster presentation.

In addition to the form below, applicants must submit one copy of the following:

- 1) a description of their research, including goals, methods to be used, and significance. The proposal should be written by the applicant and should not exceed 2 pages (double spaced).
- 2) a brief statement of career goals (no more than $\frac{1}{2}$ page, double spaced)
- 3) a copy of their graduate transcript
- 4) 2 letters of support: one from their advisor and one from another faculty member. These should be emailed directly to <u>mikesell.22@osu.edu</u> by May 1, 2024
