CRB student/postdoc travel award policy

Purpose

The purpose of the Center for RNA Biology Travel Award is to provide funds to support student/postdoc participation in (1) scientific conferences, meetings or workshops at which the student will be presenting a poster or giving a talk, or (2) workshops or courses that are critical for the trainee's professional development and career plan.

Conditions of award

- Each trainee is eligible for up to ONE award each fiscal year.
- Each trainee can request up to \$1,000 per award.
- The funds can be used toward travel, accommodation or registration costs.
- For scientific meetings, the trainee must be presenting a poster or giving an oral presentation to be eligible.
- For professional development workshops or courses, the trainee must justify how attending the event is critical for their professional development and career plan.

How and when to apply

- Applications will be accepted throughout the year
- Complete the travel award application form and submit it to the CRB office.

How decisions will be made

- Awards will be granted by the CRB Director on a first-come first-served basis until the travel award funds available for that fiscal year have been depleted.
- Decisions will be made based on the importance of the meeting for the trainee's professional development, as explained in the justification.
- Priority will be given to students that are post-candidacy.
